Inside, a thoughtful layout places all bedrooms at one end of the home for privacy and comfort. The master suite features three separate walk-in wardrobe/dressing spaces in addition to a private ensuite. Three additional double bedrooms each include built-in robes and share a spacious family bathroom with separate w/c – ideal for busy households. Ample storage and linen presses add to

A separate studio - complete with plumbing, toilet, and power - invites endless possibilities: guest accommodation, creative workspace, home office or teenage retreat. With a light cosmetic refresh, the home offers scope to elevate finishes and fixtures at minimal cost, making it a smart investment for those with vision.

Outside, the grounds are a celebration of lifestyle: raised vegetable beds, a fire pit for starlit gatherings and sweeping lawns for play or repose. The setting is as practical as it is picturesque, with privacy assured and nature ever-present.

Families will appreciate the school zoning for both Kiama and Berry, while proximity to the boutiques, cafes and beaches of Berry, Gerringong, and Kiama ensures convenience without compromise.
